

We Need Your Help

The recession continues to bring new clients to our doors and we are seeing an increase in the number of children needing services. Last fiscal year, we served more than two million meals, an increase of 19% from the year before. This year, we anticipate the total number of families we serve to increase by 20% from last year, and must plan to serve more than 2.2 million meals.

What We Do

- **The Food Pantry Program**, our best known program, distributes packages of nutritious groceries to between 1,600 and 1,800 low-income families every week.
- **24 7 YCP** has provided 45,086 emergency food packages to families since its inception in 2003.

The Hot Meal Program serves 1,350 hot meals weekly.

- **Project Dignity** provides homeless adults with on-site showers, haircuts and laundry facilities, and helps with obtaining jobs, emergency shelter, housing, and needed services and entitlements.
- The Nutrition Initiative for Children and Families helps over 250 people incorporate fresh vegetables and whole grains into their diets through ten hands-on classes a month.
